The Way Forward (Jonathan Kimball, chair), Worship (Pam Cottingham, chair), and Preschool Management (Nora Sandquist, chair) committees will remain the same.

Common Call is a joint ministry of our church, Christ Episcopal, and Hope Lutheran (ELCA). Our goal is to help college students as they transition from the received faith of their youth to the active, personal faith of adulthood. We meet at Christ Episcopal biweekly on Sunday evenings for dinner and a study. (Christ Episcopal is more walkable for students than the other two sponsoring churches.) Last semester, we used Alpha (<u>https://alphausa.org/</u>). It's a good program, but a little too basic for the students who participated.

This semester, we are using **Living the Questions 2.0** (<u>https://livingthequestions.com/</u>). From their description: "LtQ2 is an open-minded alternative to studies that attempt to give participants all the answers and instead strives to create an environment where participants can interact with one another in exploring what's next for Christianity." We are particularly focusing on "Call to Covenant," which among other things asks participants to live out their faith.
