Greetings from the Session -

The session voted and is requesting permission to form a PNC (pastor nominating committee). Once that is approved, Deanne Jackson, elder & chair of the nominating committee, will work to bring a slate of members to the congregation for a vote. Concurrently to that process, the session will finalize the direction the church wants to go in mission. We will also guide the PNC on salary and other issues.

The session and interested members of the church have been working with Greg Emery during this transition process. Susan shared some of this in her sermon on October 31st. Simply stated, we have three options in front of us: 1) hire a traditional minister to maintain the current church, which has been declining in membership as people move or pass away, 2) hire a minister with the sole focus to build a new church, which would diminish the support for our current congregation, and 3) a hybrid model with a minister who will spend a portion of time working to build a new worshiping community that can be merged into our congregation gradually overtime. We can do this by sharing the load of leading the church between our pastor and others. Option 3 could include occasional sermons from elders or pulpit supply and visits to homebound members by deacons and others. The consensus has been for the hybrid model (option 3). Details have not been figured out, and some will depend on the person we hire.

The denomination (PCUSA) has a campaign called 1001 new worship communities.
